In this first report to the Airlift community since the election, we are focusing on two states that changed the path to the White House and the Senate: Georgia and Arizona. When Airlift started in 2017, the South and the Southwest were definitely not viewed by the political pros as the route to victory. WHAT HAPPENED IN GEORGIA

UP BALLOT:

Joseph Biden wins by 12,000 votes Ralph Warnock wins by 79,000 votes Jon Ossoff wins by 41,000 votes Lucy McBath holds CD-6 Carolyn Bourdeaux wins CD-7

DOWN BALLOT:

5 new progressive District Attorneys, including one who replaces the DA refusing to prosecute the killers of Ahmaud Arbery

4 new Black Sheriffs who run on canceling agreements with ICE to turn over immigrants

HOW IT HAPPENED

YOUTH VOTE HIGHEST IN THE COUNTRY The under 30 share of the Georgia vote is 21%, 4 points higher than the national average — and they skew heavily Democratic

BLACK VOTE UP 20% FROM 2016 Black Voters Matter works with 600 civic groups in 40 counties of Georgia's Black Belt, with some runoff voting higher than the general

LATINX VOTE UP 72% Mijente officially contacts every Latinx voter in Georgia

ASIAN-AMERICAN VOTE UP 91%

31,000 Asian-Americans vote for the first time because somebody calls them or comes to their door and talks with them in their native Bangla, Chinese, Hindi, Urdu, Korean or Vietnamese



WHAT HAPPENED IN ARIZONA

UP BALLOT

Biden wins Arizona by 10,000 votes Mark Kelly wins by 79,000 votes First time since 1958 Arizona has two Democratic senators Voters raise taxes to fund education

DOWN BALLOT

Sheriff Arpaio's office now occupied by a Democrat!

Democrats flip one state Senate and one House seat and come within 3 seats of flipping both chambers

Latina Democrat elected to state board that regulates utilities

HOW IT HAPPENED

Massive, year round organizing and delivering for the people over the past 10 years

Funders coming in early, not arriving late to the party, dropping money and walking away

LUCHA wins statewide minimum wage and paid sick leave, and their campaign includes 2,600,000 phone calls, 116,000 conversations, 58 billboards, and 14,000,000 social media impressions

CASE knocks on 800,000 doors with full COVID protocols, and has 260,000 phone conversations with voters

ARIZONA FUNDING

LESSON LEARNED: CANDIDATES DO NOT BUILD INFRASTRUCTURE

After Georgia, people are starting to understand the power of grassroots organizing in a new way. Organizing is like the Olympics. It happens every four years, but it is the work you do every day in the off-years that actually wins the gold medal.

Airlift contributions have funded 100,000 hours of year round organizing. All of our groups are still going strong. We are supporting groups in states with key Senate and House races in 2022. Our vision is to help many other states follow Georgia's lead. Let's maintain the momentum and systematically fund grassroots organizing the way we have funded Georgia and Arizona over the last 3 years.

THE POWER OF YOUR MONEY

1. AIRLIFT IS A DAVID AND GOLIATH STORY

Nationally Democrats spend \$9 billion. Grassroots groups turn hundreds of thousands of non-voters into voters and bring home NV, WI, MI, PA, AZ and GA on 5% of that.

2. ARIZONA AND GEORGIA ARE LABORATORIES

These states pioneer new ways of engaging communities, new kinds of digital storytelling, and sophisticated techniques for combating voter suppression. Fair Fight trains voter protection teams in 20 states.

3. OUR GROUPS HELP EACH OTHER

Airlift helps CASE fly hundreds of COVID-experienced canvassers to work alongside Georgia organizations in the runoff. Tram Nguyen, veteran Executive Director of New Virginia Majority, runs the Georgia election defense desk, orchestrating a carefully calibrated set of responses to each day's voter suppression tactics.
